Under the guidance of Mrs. Lyjak, 2 teams of 4th and 5th graders from our new robotics club competed last month in a First Lego League qualifier tournament with 32 local elementary and middle school teams at Wheeler High School. Each team was judged in 4 categories; a research presentation on a topic involving climate, a technical presentation about their robot design, their teamwork and their score in a robot game.

The **Lego Challengebots** team received a 3rd place trophy and 11th place overall in the research category for their presentation on the Atlanta drought.

The **Dynamite** team came in 9th place overall.

Both teams qualify for the January 10th super regional tournaments to determine who moves to the state finals.
